Dear Volunteer,

It is the policy of the Pappas Rehabilitation Hospital for Children (PRHC) to screen for Tuberculosis all persons who perform any type of volunteer service at PRHC for longer than a 6-week period. The Mantoux Tuberculin (TB) Skin Test (PPD) is required before beginning volunteer services.

Many of you have already had this test done and can obtain a letter from your doctor. If not, you need to have this test done at your doctor's office.

If that is not an option, please call Lisa Morris, LPN, Employee Health Nurse at 781-830-8546 so that arrangements can be made through the PRHC Outpatient Department.

If you are under the age of 18, you must have parental permission. Your participation in our Volunteer Program is important to us and will be pending until all documentation has been completed and returned to the Volunteer Office.
